About the Hackathon: The R&D Cell, KMIM had come up with a Hackathon themed on the most sought-after Agile methodologies aiming at enhancing the skills like critical thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, strategy building, situational analysis, leadership and team spirit among the aspiring business professionals. The Hackathon focused on providing a real-time exposure to the participants by creating a conducive environment supporting the practical application of Agile methodologies for business growth and development. The Hackathon was conducted in three different Sprints to ensure that the participants could understand and leverage the Agile methodologies in solving real-time complex business problems. The participants were given an option to choose between two Tracks on **General Management** and **ESG & Business Sustainability**. In the era of Industry 4.0 powered by rapid technological advancement, market dynamics and AI-integration, it became essential for the aspiring managers to enhance their managerial competencies with the help of scalable solutions for real-time corporate crisis. With a vision towards building a foundation of value-based and iterative problem-solving, this Hackathon looked towards directing Value-based management practices towards Viksit Bharat 2047 initiative of the Government of India.

About the theme of the Hackathon: Agile is a project management methodology that uses short development cycles to prioritize on continual improvement in the development of a product or service where requirements and solutions evolve through collaboration between self-organizing cross-functional teams. Agile project management is an approach based on delivering requirements iteratively and incrementally

throughout the project life cycle. At the core of agile is the requirement to exhibit central values and behaviors of trust, flexibility, empowerment and collaboration. Agile is characterized by the division of tasks into short phases of work and frequent reassessment and adaptation of plans. Agile reduces difficulty of planning the project, building requirements for the project, executing the product and then testing the product for flaws by breaking the big cycle into small cycle or segments. A **Sprint** is a short, time-boxed period to complete a set amount of work. Sprints are at the very heart of agile methodologies and getting sprints right will help the agile team get the work done faster and efficiently.
