As part of the World Environment Day 2026 celebrations, the Eco Club of Keshav Memorial Institute of Management organized the **"Grow Your Own Plant Activity"** on 5 June 2026. The activity was introduced as a **15-days Phase – I of the Plant Growth Challenge**, encouraging participants to nurture their plants regularly and observe their development over the coming weeks.

The session provided students with a hands-on learning experience and highlighted the significance of individual efforts in environmental conservation.
